HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS BUYING AND SELLING, I.E. DETAINING A PERSON FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPLOITATION. THIS HAPPENS BY THE USE OF FORCE OR THREAT, FRAUD, ABUSE OF AUTHORITY OR ABUSE OF THE DIFFICULT POSITION OF THE EXPLOITED PERSON, KIDNAPPING AND THE LIKE.

- › If someone other than an official person confiscates your passport or other travel or identity document,
- › If you have limited freedom of movement and can go out and or make phone calls only in the presence of others,
- › If you have no right to assistance and protection,
- › If you are subjected to violence or sexual abuse,
- › If someone else decides for you to do a work, forces you into prostitution, begging, petty crime or any other type of work,
- › If you are under constant escort or surveillance,
- › If you or your family are threatened or blackmailed,
- › If you are forced to return allegedly huge debts to those who brought you to a country.

IF YOU ARE NOT SURE WHETHER YOU NEED HELP, BUT YOU NOTICE SOME OF THESE SIGNS, YOU CAN CONTACT US, WE CAN HELP YOU ACHIEVE YOUR RIGHTS.

- › Always keep your documents with you.
- › If possible, always make a copy of your documents and keep them separate from the originals to facilitate identification in case your original documents are damaged or lost.
- › Be careful when you agree to do a favor for an unknown person in exchange for money.
- › Use public transport (bus / train) whenever you can.
- › Be careful when someone promises to give you a shelter, provide transportation or a job.
- › Do not show your money to strangers.
- › Make sure you have or learn the phone number of the police. You can call us from Serbia or from abroad if you think that we can help.

IF YOU ARE VICTIM OF TRAFFICKING, YOU ARE ENTITLED TO HELP AND SUPPORT. ALSO, YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO RESIDENCE FOR HUMANITARIAN REASONS IN SERBIA DURING THE RECOVERY PERIOD.
